“Emergency Benefits for Continuing Education for Students”

Publication date: 24 December 2021

The Government of Japan will provide financial support for international students who have difficulties in continuing their studies at universities because they are independent from their families and are paying their school fees through part-time jobs, etc., or because their income has decreased due to the spread of the new coronavirus infection. (100,000 yen will be transferred to the account in the applicant's name)

Information on how to apply will be provided in the “Summary of Scholarships” section of the “Privately Financed International Students” section of the “About Studying at Tokyo Metropolitan University” section, so please apply if you meet the requirements.

- (1) As a rule, you live outside your home.
- (2) You are not receiving a large amount of money from your family.
- (3) Additional support from your family is not expected due to a decrease in family income.
- (4) Your part-time income has decreased by more than 50% compared to the previous month and this situation has not improved this year, or you continue to be unable to earn a part-time income due to the corona infection.

Those who reside outside Japan

Those who do not have an account in a bank in Japan in their own name.
