GUIDELINES FOR LAGUAGE EXCHANGE

Please read and understand well the following before you take part in Language

Exchange.

· Language Exchange can never be carried out without relationship of mutual trust

between buddies.

• To set the date and time for a session, be sure to negotiate with your buddy in a flexible

manner.

· An unreasonable setting of a session may lead to a sudden cancellation. Set the date

and time which will allow you and your buddies a plenty of time.

· Please remember to use the first half of a session for you and the second half for your

buddy.

· It usually takes more time to think and explain in a second language than in a first

language. Try to be patiently wait until your buddy finishes speaking and try not to

cut in.

· Control the difficulty level of your language after discussing with your partner from

time to time, and try to make yourself understood easily by your partner.

· Be sure not to treat your partner like a small child when she/he is not good at his/her

second language. Also keep it in mind; your buddy might not want to get too much

help from you.

· Respect the language, culture, sense of value, liking, personality and privacy of your

buddy.

· You must carefully decide when and what you will tell your buddy regarding your

personal information.

· You must not let out the personal information of your buddy to any third person.

· To improve this language exchange project, a questionnaire is carried out at the end of

each semester. Students who participated in only the first session are also requested

to respond the questionnaire.

· Your regular class work and research work is more important than this Language

Exchange; place top priority always on your study.
