## GLOBAL FUTURES SCHOLARSHIP (GFS)

By providing financial support, we aim to empower these future leaders to focus fully on their academic pursuits, envisioning and creating their own paths at our university.

GFS must be applied for at the time of admission. Applicants will be selected based on a comprehensive review of:

1. Academic performance based on entrance examination results
2. Scholarship Motivation Letter
3. Global Diversity based on the priority regions

### SCHOLARSHIP HIGHLIGHTS

**Monthly Stipend:**  
**JPY 100,000**  
(JPY 1.2M / year)

**Tuition Support:**  
**50%**

**Duration:**  
**4 Years**

- GFS recipients who demonstrate outstanding academic performance during their studies may be awarded additional support, such as an increased monthly stipend (JPY 20,000) and full tuition exemption.
- TMU also offers a range of scholarships that students can apply for after enrollment.

## ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for the Global Futures Scholarship, applicants must satisfy all of the following requirements:

### 1. Academic Program and Admission

Apply for and be admitted to one of the **designated undergraduate English-taught degree programs** at TMU through the specified entrance examinations.

#### Regional Priority Consideration (Optional)

Applicants holding nationality of a country or region listed in the Priority Regions will be considered under the university’s regional priority selection criteria.

### 2. Residency and Visa Status

- Be a **non-Japanese national** residing outside of Japan at the time of application.
- Be able to **newly obtain a "Student" visa** to enter and reside in Japan upon admission.

## GLOBAL DIVERSITY: PRIORITY REGIONS

### Southwest Asia

India, Sri Lanka, Nepal, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Maldives

### CIS

Uzbekistan, Kazakhstan, Azerbaijan, Georgia, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, etc.

### Southeast Asia (ASEAN)

Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, Brunei, Vietnam, Laos, Myanmar, Cambodia

### Sub-Saharan Africa

South Africa, Kenya, Nigeria, Ghana, other African countries

### Middle East & North Africa

Egypt, Turkey, UAE, Saudi Arabia, Qatar, etc.
