

Tokyo Metropolitan University (TMU) Global Futures Scholarship

SCHOLARSHIP OBJECTIVE

This scholarship program is established to attract and support outstanding international students who demonstrate exceptional academic potential. **Eligibility is limited to applicants for designated undergraduate English-taught degree programs.** By providing financial support, we aim to empower these future leaders to focus fully on their academic pursuits, envisioning and creating their own paths at our university.

Selection Policy

Scholarship recipients are selected based on at least one of the following criteria during the entrance examination process:

- **Academic Excellence:** Recognizes high-ranking applicants who demonstrate outstanding academic performance in the entrance examination, regardless of nationality.
- **Global Diversity:** Recognizes talented applicants from university-designated priority regions (refer to "List of Priority Regions" in Attachment 1), aimed at fostering a diverse campus environment.

NUMBER OF RECIPIENTS

Up to 10

Note: The final number of recipients may be fewer than 10 depending on the number of applicants and their performance in the entrance examination.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for the Global Futures Scholarship, applicants must satisfy all of the following requirements:

1. Academic Program and Admission

Apply for and be admitted to one of the designated undergraduate English-taught degree programs at TMU through the specified entrance examinations (Refer to Attachment 2 for details).

2. Residency and Visa Status

- Be a non-Japanese national residing outside of Japan at the time of application.
- Be able to newly obtain a "Student" visa to enter and reside in Japan upon admission.

3. Regional Priority Consideration (Optional)

Applicants holding the nationality of a country or region listed in the "List of Priority Regions" (Attachment 1) will be considered under the university's regional priority selection criteria.

BENEFITS

- **Stipend:** JPY 100,000 per month (JPY 1,200,000 per year)
- **Tuition Support:** Half Tuition Reduction

SCHOLARSHIP PERIOD

Standard Duration: 4 years (from April 2027 to March 2031).

Note: The scholarship is limited to a maximum of 4 years. Furthermore, the university reserves the right to suspend or terminate scholarship payments if a recipient fails to progress to the next year due to poor performance or engages in conduct that results in disciplinary action.

APPLICATION PROCESS AND PERIOD

The application for this scholarship is integrated with the university admission process and follows the steps below:

Step 1: Intent to Apply (During Admission Application)

Applicants must indicate their intent to apply for the scholarship on the Application Form (志願票) when submitting their application documents for the entrance examination.

Important Note: Please be aware that you will **NOT be eligible to apply for this scholarship if you do not indicate your intent during the admission application process.**

Step 2: Scholarship Submission (After Admission Acceptance)

Upon formal acceptance of your admission application, the International Affairs Office will contact you via email with detailed instructions and the exact deadlines for the scholarship application.

Step 3: Notification of Selection Results

Applicants will be notified of the scholarship selection results through the online application system (or via email) by December 28 (Mon), 2026.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION ITEMS

All required information, including a motivation letter, must be submitted via the online application system “LoGo Form”. The URL for the scholarship application form will be sent directly to applicants who have indicated their intention to apply for this scholarship on the Application Form (志願票).

1. Online Scholarship Application Form

Please input all required information directly into the LoGo Form.

2. Scholarship Motivation Letter

This statement should clearly explain why you are a suitable candidate for achieving the objectives of the scholarship.

SCREENING

Applicants will be selected based on a comprehensive review of:

1. **Academic performance** based on entrance examination results.
2. **Scholarship Motivation Letter**
3. Contribution to **Global Diversity** based on the priority regions.

NOTICE OF RESULTS

- **Notification:** Scholarship results will be sent via email following the announcement of final successful applicants. If you do not receive this notification by December 28 (Mon), 2026, please reach out to the email address provided in the "Contact" section at the end of these guidelines, as there may have been a delivery issue. Please be advised that **you will forfeit your right to apply for the scholarship if you fail to submit your application by the specified deadline**, even in cases where you did not receive the notification email but failed to contact the office for confirmation.
- **Procedure for Successful Candidates:** Recipients can download their **Scholarship Award Certificate** from the online portal.

NOTES

- **Cancellation of Eligibility:** The scholarship offer will be revoked if the recipient fails to enroll in the university or fails to submit all required enrollment documents by the designated deadline. In addition, if any false statements are identified in the applicant's eligibility or application information, the scholarship may be canceled and repayment of all or part of the funds may be required, even after enrollment.

- **Combining Scholarships:** In principle, recipients cannot combine this award with other institutional scholarships.
- **Use of Application Information:** To streamline the selection process and avoid redundant data collection, TMU will utilize the personal information and documents submitted at the time of your entrance examination application to determine eligibility and select awardees for this scholarship.
